## Saint Théodore Guérin

A long time ago, when Anne-Thérèse Guérin was a child, she wanted to serve God. When she was 25 years-old, Anne-Thérèse became a Sister of Providence and took the name, Sister Saint Théodore. She taught children and cared for the poor and sick in France.

After 16 years, a bishop in the United States needed some help. So Mother Théodore went with five nuns to America to build schools and orphanages.

At first, Mother Théodore and the nuns were cold and lonely. Over the years, people learned to trust the sisters. Like Mary, Mother Théodore lived a life of courage. She always trusted God.

The Church honors Mother Théodore Guérin as a saint and celebrates her feast day on October 3.

Help your child to recognize the ways your family is living this virtue. Remind them that when they say yes to God, they are living as disciples of Jesus.
