

God Made All People

Overview

In Chapter 5 the children learned that God made the animals as gifts for us. In this chapter, the children will learn that God made all people good and that God loves all people.

Doctrinal Content	For Adult Reading and Reflection Catechism of the Catholic Church
The children will learn:	

Catechist Background

What family resemblances do you observe in your family?

When a new baby is born, one of the first questions people ask is, "Whom does the child look like?" In many families we notice physical resemblances. The very observant can also recognize non-physical characteristics that family members have in common, such as tones of voice, phrases, and mannerisms. Such similarities are even found among family members who are not genetically related. So, too, there are common characteristics shared by the family of God.

God our Creator made all people. The Book of Genesis has two stories about the creation of people. In the first account, human beings, male and female, are created on the sixth day. They are created in the image and likeness of God. The emphasis throughout this account is on the goodness of all that God has created. From this account we learn that all people, everywhere and throughout time, are made in the image of God. In the second account of creation in Genesis, we are told that God created Adam first, and then Eve from Adam's rib. Eve is called the "mother of all the living" (Genesis 3:20). From this account of creation, we learn that all people are meant to live in unity as God's family because we all share common ancestors.

God loves the people he has created. All that he asks is that his creatures love him in return. This is not because God needs our love, but simply because he desires it. God's love is given freely, as is his act of creation. So, too, is our love to be given freely. This is not a simple task, but a challenging one worthy of those who are made in the image of God.



Collect picture books about other countries and cultures. Select a few titles to read aloud to the children. Display all the books as a way to introduce and expose the children to people of many cultures from around the world. Remind the children that God made all people of the world.

If time permits, you can watch short videos of children living in other countries around the world.

Also invite people from the children's families or ethnic communities to visit the class. Pray for all the people in the particular countries you have talked about.

Lesson Plan

WE GATHER

__ minutes

Tray Invite the children to think about all the different people in the world. Then read the Scripture verse.

Focus on Life Have the children study the pictures on page 77. Read aloud the We Gather question and invite the children to offer their responses. Tell the children that they will learn that God made all people and has given them many gifts.

WE BELIEVE

minutes

Hold up the globe and explain that people live in countries all over the world. Then read the *We Believe* statement and paragraph that follows.

Point to the picture of the park. Ask the children to name one of God's greatest creations that is not in the picture (people).

Read the activity directions aloud. Tell the children that they can draw on the page or cut out pictures from magazines and paste them in the appropriate places. When all of the children have completed their work, invite them to share their pictures with one another. Talk about the ways in which the people are enjoying God's world.

Curriculum Connection Language Arts

Activity Materials: stories about differences

Invite volunteers to take turns telling stories they have heard in which a character has a different trait. Some examples would be "The Ugly Duckling," "Dumbo, the Elephant;" "Rudolph, the Red-Nosed Reindeer," or "Stuart Little." After each volunteer tells the story, discuss how each character used the gifts that he or she had been given. When all the stories have been told, ask the children what they learned from them.

Quick Check


- ✓ Who made everyone in the world? (God made everyone in the world.)
- What did God give people? (God gave people the world and all the good things in it.)

Remind the children that God made all people good and gave them special gifts. Ask: What are some of the gifts that God gives people? (Possible responses include the gifts of creation talked about in Unit 1.) Encourage the children to take turns naming gifts they have received from God.

Teaching Tip

Idea for a Bulletin Board

Use photos from magazines to make a bulletin board entitled "God Loves All the People." Refer to the photos on the bulletin board when talking about the ways people are different and how God loves each and every one.



Lesson Plan

WE BELIEVE (continued)

Read aloud the *We Believe* statement and paragraph. Ask: *What are the people in the picture doing?* (smiling) *Why do you think they are smiling?* (Possible response is they know that God loves them.)

Ask the children to describe the ways the people on the page differ from one another. Remind the children that God loves them all. Read the activity directions aloud. Invite the children to add themselves to the picture. Tell them they belong in the picture because God loves them, too.

WE RESPOND

minutes

Connect to Life Read the activity directions aloud. Invite the children to work in pairs to talk about what the people in each picture are doing to share God's love. Then ask them to decide where to paste the hearts. Have the children cut out the hearts and paste them near the pictures they have chosen. When all the students have completed the activity, invite the pairs to explain where they pasted their hearts and why.

Multiple Intelligences Bodily-Kinesthetic

Discuss with the children ways in which they can share God's love. For example, they can help a child who has fallen down to get up. Invite a pair of volunteers to pantomime sharing God's love. Ask the other children to guess what the pair is acting out. Let other pairs have a turn.

Materials for Wreath


We Believe Booklet

Tell the children that they are going to read a booklet called "The People We See." Say: This booklet will help you remember the many different kinds of people God made. Help the children to fold their booklets.

Read each page of the booklet. After you read the question *Who made these people?* on page 1, 2, and 3, pause to allow the children to answer *God*.

Extend with the Reproducible Master

Explain that the children will make a wreath that will remind them that God loves everyone. Distribute copies of Reproducible Master 8, as well as the supplies the children will need. Show the children the wreath that you completed. Invite the children to color the picture of the people, cut it out, and then glue it on a paper plate to make a wreath. Help each child punch a hole at the top of the plate and loop string or yarn through the hole to make a hanger. As the children complete their wreaths, encourage them to share them with one another.
