


To trust someone is to believe that person will always do what is best for us.

#### This Week . . .

In Chapter 5, "Mary, the Mother of Jesus," your child learned:

- Mary is the mother of Jesus, the Son of God. Mary is the Mother of God.
- ▶ The Gospel account of the Annunciation shares with us Mary's faith and trust in God and her love for him.
- Courage helps us trust in God and live our faith, even in difficult times.

#### Sharing God's Word

Read together Luke 1:26–38, the Gospel account of the Annunciation. Or read the adaptation of the story on page 68. Emphasize Mary's failth and trust in God and her love for him.

#### We Live as Disciples

The Christian home and family is a school of discipleship. Choose one or more of the following activities to do as a family, or design a similar activity of your own.

► Teach your child the Mass responses "Thanks be to God" and "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ." Guide your child to use these responses properly when your family takes part in the celebration of the Mass.

Courage is the virtue that helps us trust God and live our faith. Help your child to recognize the ways your family is living this virtue. Remind them that when they say yes to God, they are living as a disciple of Jesus.

#### Our Spiritual Journey

The psalms are a profession of faith in song. From the time of David until the present, praying of the psalms has nourished the faith of the People of God. This prayer is both personal and communal. Memorize psalm verses such as the one on page 75 and pray them spontaneously to respond to the various circlumstances of your life.
