


When we make a **RIPPLE of LOVE** we are making a choice. We are **GLOOSING to LOVE**.

Once there was a shepherd who had 100 sheep. Every day he watched over his sheep and kept them safe.






Every night he counted his sheep to make sure they were all there.



Then the priest forgives my sins through the love of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit.




The priest's words of forgiveness bring me very close to God and my brothers and sisters.
