

God Made All People

Overview

In Chapter 5 the children learned that God made the animals as gifts for us. In this chapter, the children will learn that God made all people good and that God loves all people.

Catechist Background

What family resemblances do you observe in your family?

When a new baby is born, one of the first questions people ask is, "Whom does the child look like?" In many families we notice physical resemblances. The very observant can also recognize non-physical characteristics that family members have in common, such as tones of voice, phrases, and mannerisms. Such similarities are even found among family members who are not genetically related. So, too, there are common characteristics shared by the family of God.

God our Creator made all people. The Book of Genesis has two stories about the creation of people. In the first account, human beings, male and female, are created on the sixth day. They are created in the image and likeness of God. The emphasis throughout this account is on the goodness of all that God has created. From this account we learn that all people, everywhere and throughout time, are made in the image of God. In the second account of creation in Genesis, we are told that God created Adam first, and then Eve from Adam's rib. Eve is called the "mother of all the living" (Genesis 3:20). From this account of creation, we learn that all people are meant to live in unity as God's family because we all share common ancestors.

God loves the people he has created. All that he asks is that his creatures love him in return. This is not because God needs our love, but simply because he desires it. God's love is given freely, as is his act of creation. So, too, is our love to be given freely. This is not a simple task, but a challenging one worthy of those who are made in the image of God.

♣ Pray Invite the children to think about all the different people in the world. Then read the Scripture verse.

Focus on Life Have the children study the pictures on page 77. Read aloud the We Gather question and invite the children to offer their responses. This would be a good time to read and discuss the Chapter Story on page 77C. It is about a neighborhood that includes people of diverse backgrounds. Tell the children that in this lesson they will learn that God made all people and has given them many gifts.



minutes

Hold up the globe and explain that people live in countries all over the world. Then read the *We Believe* statement and paragraph that follows.

Point to the picture of the park. Ask the children to name one of God's greatest creations that is not in the picture (people).

Read the activity directions aloud. Tell the children that they can draw on the page or cut out pictures from magazines and paste them in the appropriate places. When all of the children have completed their work, invite them to share their pictures with one another. Talk about the ways in which the people are enjoying God's world.



ACTIVITY BANK

Curriculum Connection Language Arts

Activity Materials: stories about differences

Invite volunteers to take turns telling stories they have heard in which a character has a different trait. Some examples would be "The Ugly Duckling;" "Pumbo, the Elephant;" "Rudolph, the Red-Nosed Reindeer;" or "Stuart Little." After each volunteer tells the story, discuss how each character used the gifts that he or she had been given. When all the stories have been told, ask the children what they learned from them.

Quick Check

- Who made everyone in the world? (God made everyone in the world.)
- ✓ What did God give people? (God gave people the world and all the good things in it.)

WE RESPOND (Guide Only) ___ minute

Connect to Life Remind the children that God made all people good and gave them special gifts. Ask: What are some of the gifts that God gives people?

(Possible responses include the gifts of creation talked about in Unit 1.) Encourage the children to take turns naming gifts they have received from God.

Pray Conclude the lesson by asking the children to repeat each line of this prayer after you read it aloud: God, we thank you for making all people. Amen.



Thank you for people all over the world.

Focus on Life Remind the children that God made everyone and placed people in every part of the world. Encourage the children to share what they know about people who live in faraway places. Tell the children that in this lesson they will learn that God loves all people.

WE BELIEVE

minutes

Read aloud the We Believe statement and paragraph. Ask: What are the people in the pictures doing? (smiling) Why do you think they are smiling? (Possible response is they know that God loves them.)

Ask the children to describe the ways the people on the page differ from one another. Remind the children that God loves them all. Read the activity directions aloud. Invite the children to add themselves to the picture. Tell them they belong in the picture because God loves them, too.



ACTIVITY BANK

Multiple Intelligences

Bodily-Kinesthetic

Discuss with the children ways in which they can share God's love. For example, they can help a child who has fallen down to get up. Invite a pair of volunteers to pantomime sharing God's love. Ask the other children to guess what the pair is acting out. Let other pairs have a turn.

Curriculum Connection

Activity Materials: several colors of tempera paint, paint brushes, drawing paper

Review the pictures of different people (in the We Believe text, the bulletin board, books, and so on). Then invite the children to paint one person they have seen in a photo. Later encourage the children to talk about their paintings. Display the paintings as one mural entitled "God Loves Us All!"


Connect to Life Read the activity directions aloud. Invite the children to work in pairs to talk about what is happening in each picture and to decide where to paste the hearts. Then have the children cut out the hearts and paste them near the pictures they have chosen. When all the students have completed the activity, invite the pairs to explain where they pasted their hearts and why. Help the children to understand that all the people in the pictures are sharing God's love.

Pray Conclude the lesson by having the children recite after you this prayer: God, help us to share your love today.

Plan Ahead for Day 3

Catechist Goal: To emphasize that God made all people different

Preparation: Prepare a list of similarities and differences of people.

WE GATHER

__ minutes

Tray Ask the children to think about God. Invite them to repeat each line of this prayer.

God, help me listen today.

Teach me more about your people.

Teach me more about your love.

Focus on Life Discuss what the children have learned in this chapter about ways that people are different. (People come from different countries, look different, speak different languages, and so on.) Point out: Some people are good at sports; others are good at painting. Discuss these types of differences among people. Tell the children that in this lesson they will learn that God made all people different and with different abilities.

WE BELIEVE

__ minutes

Make the Booklet Tell the children that they are going to read a booklet called "The People We See." Say: This booklet will help you remember the many different kinds of people God made. Help the children to fold their booklets.

Read each page of the booklet. After you read the question *Who* made these people? on page 1, 2, and 3, pause to allow the children to answer *God*.

WE RESPOND

_ minutes

Connect to Life Give each child a sheet of drawing paper. Show the children how to fold it in half to make a booklet. On page 1, have the children draw themselves wearing their favorite clothes. On page 2, have the children draw themselves eating their favorite food. On page 3, have the children draw themselves doing one of their favorite activities. On page 4, have the children draw people in their families.

Pray Conclude the lesson by having the children echo this prayer: Thank you, God, for making all people different. Thank you, God, for making all of us. Amen.

ACTIVITY BANK

Curriculum Connection

Social Studies

Activity Materials: magazines or books with pictures of people in several different ethnic settings

Show the pictures to the children. If possible, identify the country the people live in and point it out on the globe. Invite the children to look at the pictures of all the people and have each child choose one person who interests him or her. Ask each child to explain to the group why the person caught his or her attention. Use the opportunity to affirm the uniqueness of each individual.



Tray Ask the children to pray after you: God, you have made us all different and special. Thank you for loving us. Amen.

Focus on Life Ask the children: Is someone in your family taller or smaller than you? Have volunteers respond and also describe other ways they differ from members of their family. Ask everyone: How could you show each member of your family that you appreciate him or her? Let them identify ways such as telling another person what they like about him or her or helping that person. Tell the children that in today's lesson they will make something to help them remember what they have learned in the chapter:

- · God made everyone.
- · God loves all people.

WE BELIEVE

minutes

Extend with the Reproducible Master Explain that the children will make a wreath that will remind them that God loves everyone. Distribute copies of Reproducible Master 8, as well as the supplies the children will need. Show the children the wreath that you completed. Invite the children to color the picture of the people, cut it out, and then glue it on a paper plate to make a wreath. Help each child punch a hole at the top of the plate and loop string or yarn through the hole to make a hanger. As the children complete their wreaths, encourage them to share them with one another.

WE RESPOND

_ minutes

Connect to Life Discuss with the children what life would be like if everyone looked and acted the same. Ask: *Would you like it?* Help the children to appreciate the wonderful gifts and talents each person has. Emphasize that God expects us to use our gifts and talents to love him and to help one another.

Pray Conclude the lesson by having the children echo this prayer: God, thank you for all the wonderful people in the world.

Teaching Note

Self-Acceptance

Kindergarten is a time for self-discovery. Through exploration into new activities, children gradually learn that some things come easily to them while others do not. Help each child, on a daily and individual basis, to "accentuate the positive." When things do not work out as hoped, ward off discouragement by reminding the children: Some things take more time. You'll get tit Try again later!

- Gather the children in the prayer space. Tell them that they will be like the children in the drawing. They will sing and dance to thank God for making the many people in our world.
- **Say:** God loves every person in the world. He made every person different with different looks and gifts. God wants us to love everyone he has created.
- **Invite** the children to sing the song. Have the children play the instruments or clap their hands as they sing the first time.
- **Then** have the children join their hands to form a circle. Sing the song again.

Ideas for Reviewing the Chapter

- **Review** with the children what they learned about the people God made.
- Invite the children to talk about ways God shows love for all people (giving them families, friends, food, and so on). Give each child a large light blue paper circle. Tell the children that the blue circle stands for the world. Invite them to draw a picture that shows something they learned about God and his love for all people.
- **Display** the globe and ask the children to point to a country on it. Read the name of the country. Invite the children to say with you: God, we pray for the people in (name of country).


