List three things John might say or do to show Brad how happy he is about Brad's visit.






The night before Jesus died, he said to his disciples, "Don't worry. I will always be with you. I will send the Holy Spirit to stay close to you forever."


oust as the Holy Spirit filled Jesus' followers with wonder and praise at Pentecost, the Holy Spirit fills us with new life today!

One of the ways the Holy Spirit brings new life to the Church today is in the sacraments.

In Baptism, the Holy Spirit gives us new life in Jesus. We become members of the Church. We are part of God's family.

In Confirmation, the Holy Spirit makes our Baptismal faith stronger. We will learn to share our faith in Jesus by serving others. The Holy Spirit helps us tell others about Jesus' love.

In the Eucharist, the Holy Spirit changes our gifts of bread and wine into the gifts of Jesus' Body and Blood. The Holy Spirit also changes us. The Holy Spirit helps us unite with Jesus. Together we give God our lives and our love. We grow closer to God and one another. We show the world the love of Jesus who died on the cross for us.



As Catholics, we try to live the same way Jesus did. We can ask the Holy Spirit to guide us. The Holy Spirit helps us make good choices that keep us close to God and one another. We call this holiness.

Sometimes we say or do things that turn us away from God and others who love us. We call this sin.



When we have hurt one another, the Holy Spirit helps heal our friendships. Reconciliation is a sacrament of healing. In the Holy Spirit, we can hope that God will make things right again.



## Living in the Spirit

Diving in the Spirit means following Jesus and believing Jesus is with us. It also means celebrating the sacraments with the family of the Church and listening to God in prayer.

Jesus is with us today through the grace of the Holy Spirit. Grace is the gift of God's love and presence in our lives that helps us live as Jesus taught.

We ask the Holy Spirit to help and guide us. When we sin, the Holy Spirit helps us to be sorry. When we make good choices, the Holy Spirit helps us to be holy.
