Matthew 4:18-20

Read Along

One day Jesus was walking by the sea. He saw two brothers fishing. Their names were Peter and Andrew.

Jesus invited Peter and Andrew to be his followers. "At once they left their nets and followed him." (Matthew 4:20) Jesus asked other men and women to be his followers, too. Those who became his followers learned from him.

They tried to act as Jesus did. They shared God's love with others as Jesus did. They became his friends.

Jesus had many followers. The **Apostles** were the twelve men Jesus chose to lead his followers.

Luke 8:22–25

Read Along

One day Jesus was in a boat with his followers. He fell asleep. Soon a storm started rocking the boat. Jesus' followers were afraid. They woke Jesus up. They believed he would help them.

Jesus told the winds and waves to be still. Jesus' followers were amazed because the storm stopped. They asked, "Who then is this, who commands even the winds and the sea, and they obey him?" (Luke 8:25)

Jesus did amazing things to help people. Jesus calmed the storm. He did many things that only God can do. Jesus' followers saw these things and believed in him. They believed Jesus was the Son of God.

Read Along

One day Jesus was praying. When he was finished, one of his followers asked him to teach the group to pray.

Jesus told his followers, "When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed be your name.'" (Luke 11:2) We call the prayer Jesus taught his followers the **Lord's Prayer**. We also call this prayer the Our Father. Here are the words we pray.



Lord's Prayer the prayer Jesus taught his followers

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.


