I know that I'm special to God. I'm his friend.


Sometimes I make a choice that doesn't show love for God or others. This hurts my friendship with him. I sin.

When I sin, I can say this to let God know that I'm sorry.






This is my happy face after I say "I'm sorry."

I name to myself the sins I need to confess. Now I am ready to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.




Individual Rite of Reconciliation

The priest welcomes me in Jesus' name.

I pray the Sign of the Cross.

Help me trace the letters.

The priest invites me to trust in God's mercy and love.

Then the priest gives me a penance.

It may be a prayer to pray or a good deed to do.
