Veronica and Simon

Do you remember the story of Jesus carrying his Cross? The story is retold prayerfully in the Stations of the Cross. Look for the Stations of the Cross in your parish Church. Here is part of that story.

As Jesus walked up the hilly streets of Jerusalem, he stumbled and fell to the ground three times. There was a man named Simon in the crowd who saw Jesus fall. He reached down, picked up the heavy Cross, and helped Jesus carry it. Simon was from Cyrene, a northern city in Africa. He had come to Jerusalem to celebrate Passayer.

Veronica and other women disciples of Jesus were there. As Jesus walked by, Veronica offered Jesus a cloth to wipe the sweat and blood from his face. Jesus saw that she and the other women were worried about him. He told the women not to worry. Jesus' words to the women gave them hope. We remember Simon and Veronica for their acts of kindness to Jesus.

How could you have helped Jesus on his way to the Cross?

The Stations of the Cross

Three hundred years after Jesus lived. the mother of the Emperor became a Christian, Helena and other Christians went to Jerusalem to find the holy places where Jesus died and was buried. Theu walked through the narrow, rocky streets up to the hill of Calvary. They marked holy places, or stations, along the way where they stopped to pray. These places became the Stations of the Cross.

Many Christians who could not travel to Jerusalem marked stations on their church walls. Walking along and praying the Stations of the Cross became a popular devotion

Today, especially during Lent, many Catholics gather to pray the Stations of the Cross. They remember Jesus' great love for us.

The Paschal Mystery

Jesus' last meal with his disciples was the Passover meal. We call this meal the Last Supper. During the meal, Jesus told the Apostles that one of them would betray him. They all said, "Not I, Lord."

After the meal ended, Jesus and the Apostles went to a garden on a hillside near Jerusalem to pray. There Judas, one of the Apostles, betrayed Jesus. Judas brought the leaders of the Jewish community and Temple guards to the garden. Judas kissed Jesus. This signaled the guards to arrest Jesus.

The leaders took Jesus to the Roman governor, Pontius Pilate. Pilate questioned Jesus but could not find Jesus guilty of any crime. But Pilate ordered that Jesus be put to death on a cross because the crowds demanded it.

Jesus Dies on the Cross

The soldiers mocked Jesus. They placed a crown of thorny branches on his head. After the soldiers beat him, they led Jesus out of Jerusalem to a place called Golgotha. There they nailed Jesus onto a cross.

It was now about noon and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon. ... Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit," and when he had said this he breathed his last.

LUKE 23:44, 46

Jesus' Death on the Cross is called the Crucifixion. Jesus freely made a **sacrifice** of his life to save all people from their sin.

Jesus Rises to New Life and august

After Jesus died and was buried, his disciples thought they had lost him forever. Three days later, they heard some amazing news. They learned that Jesus was alive. He had risen from the dead. Here is what Matthew's Gospel describes:

Three days later, some women who were disciples of Jesus went to the tomb where the body of Jesus was placed. When the women arrived at the tomb and looked into it, they did not see Jesus' body. It was not there. An angel said to them, "God has raised Jesus from the dead! He is not here. Go and tell the other disciples to go to Galilee and wait there. Jesus will meet them there."

BASED ON MATTHEW 27:59-60; 28:1, 5-7

This event is the Resurrection. It is the heart of the Church's faith in Jesus.

Jesus Returns to His Father

The Risen Jesus stayed with his disciples for forty days. During that time, he appeared to his disciples many times. When it was time for him to return to his Father in Heaven.

[Jesus] led them out as far as Bethany, raised his hands, and blessed them. As he blessed them he parted from them and was taken up to heaven.

We call Jesus' return to his Father the Ascension. The word *ascension* means "a rising up."

The suffering or Passion, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus is called the **Paschal Mystery**. The Paschal Mystery is Jesus' passing over from death to a new and alorified life.

Because of the Paschal Mystery, we hope in the promise of everlasting life. We can hope that after we die, we will live forever with God, the angels, Mary, and all the Saints in happiness with God.

Saint Joseph of Arimathea

Joseph of Arimathea was a disciple of Jesus. After Jesus died, he asked Pilate for the body of Jesus. Joseph helped place Jesus' body in a newly made tomb in the side of a mountain. It was a tomb Joseph had made for himself.



Faith Focus

Why do we light the Paschal candle at Easter?



Each year the Church celebrates the Paschal Mystery of Jesus. On Holy Saturday evening, we celebrate the Easter Vigil. The church is in darkness. The priest blesses a new fire outdoors. He then uses the fire to light a special candle. It is the Paschal candle.

It is a symbol of Jesus, the Light of the world. It represents the light of Christ. From it, we light candles throughout the church. Our celebration of Easter has begun.

The Paschal candle tells a story. There are five red grains of incense on the candle. They remind us of the five wounds of Jesus—on his hands, his feet, and in his side. The Alpha and Omega are the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet. They remind us that Jesus is the beginning and the end of everything. The numbers for the year tell us that Jesus is with us now.

We light the Paschal candle and place it near the altar during the Easter season. The Church also lights the Paschal candle for Baptism because it brings people into the light of Christ.
