H Scripture Background

Before the Time of Tesus

Genesis and Creation Genesis, the first book of the Bible, tells the story of Creation and of God's encounter with his first people. The Genesis account was not intended to be a scientific or historical account of Creation. The authors of Genesis used the literary form of an allegory to reveal important truths about the nature of God. These truths include the preexistence of God, his wisdom


and goodness, God's power through which all things are made, and the Creation of man and woman in God's own image and likeness. The truth that God created everything good


is repeated over and over again in Genesis.

OUR CATHOLIC TRADITION in Science

Teilhard de Chardin Many people think there is a conflict between believing in the Bible and believing in evolution. They believe that if God created the world, then evolution could not have taken place. A French Jesuit priest in the early twentieth century tried to help us see God's hand in the scientific universe Pierre Teilhard de Chardin taught that evolution was the ongoing work of God. He once wrote that he wanted to teach people how to see God everywhere, even in the most hidden places in the world.






