

#### The Liturgy of the Church

When the Church gathers to celebrate the liturgy, it is doing an important work. The word liturgy means "a public work," or "work of the people." The liturgy is the work of the Church, the Body of Christ, of worshipping God.

The liturgy is also the work of God the Holy Trinity. God the Father blesses us with the gift of the Son. Jesus the Son of God blesses us with his Body and Blood. God the Holy Spirit blesses us with the gift of God's own life and love.



The priest leads the assembly of the faithful who have gathered to worship God. The priest acts together with and in the name and person of Jesus Christ, the Head of the Church.

In the liturgy, the Church gathers with Jesus Christ. We both receive God's blessings and bless and give thanks to God the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit. The Church prays,

"How wonderful are you. LORD God.

Everyone on earth worships you and sings praises to you."


taking part in the celebration of the liturgy of the Church. The liturgy of the Church centers around the Eucharist and the other sacraments.

#### **Celebrating God's Work**

Through the celebration of the liturgy, we become sharers in the saving work of Jesus Christ and in the life of God. We remember, celebrate, and share in God's work among us today.

The Church joins with Jesus to celebrate the liturgy. We remember and are made sharers in the Paschal Mystery. The Paschal Mystery is God's work of saving all people in Jesus

Christ. It is the work of Salvation accomplished by Christ's life, Passion, death, Resurrection, and glorious Ascension.



When the Church celebrates the liturgy, "remembering" has a special meaning. It means more than simply recalling what God has done for us in the past. The events of Jesus' life, Passion, death, Resurrection, and Ascension are made present again. What Jesus did while he was on earth, he continues now. We join with Christ and share in his work of Salvation.

## Faith-Filled People

#### John the Apostle

Saint John was the youngest of the Apostles chosen by Jesus. Jesus gave John and his brother James, who was also an Apostle, the nickname "sons of thunder" (Mark 3:17). Saint John stood by the cross with Mary during the suffering and death of Jesus. The Church celebrates the feast day of Saint John the Apostle and Evangelist on December 27.

Triduum. The center of the liturgical year, the three-day celebration of Jesue' Paschal Mystery beginning on Holy Thursday and continuing on Good Friday through the Easter Vigil/Easter Sunday.

When we hear really good news, we want to share it with others over and over again. What good news have you shared with others? Why did you want to share it? We share the good news of God's saving love for us over and over again when we celebrate the liturgy.

#### The Liturgical Year

The Church celebrates the liturgy every day of the year. This is called the liturgical year. The liturgical year is made up of feasts and seasons that celebrate God's great plan of saving love in Christ. These are the seasons of the liturgical year.

Advent. Think about a time when you waited for, or expected, something or someone. The season of Advent is a time of expectation. We wait and prepare for the coming of Jesus. We prepare for our celebration of Christ's first coming and look forward to his Second Coming at the end of time.

Christmas. During the Christmas season we celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, the Savior of all people, whom God promised to send.



Lent. During the season of Lent we prepare for Easter. Lent is a time to prepare to welcome new members into the Church and to renew our own baptismal promises and profession of faith.

The Triduum. The word triduum means "three days." The Triduum is the center of the liturgical year. It is our three-day celebration of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil/Easter Sunday. The Triduum begins with the evening celebration of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday and concludes with Evening Prayer, or Vespers, on Easter Sunday.

**Easter**. For fifty days, from Easter Sunday to Pentecost, we continue to celebrate that Christ is risen and will come again.

Ordinary Time. The remaining weeks of the liturgical year are called Ordinary Time. We listen and respond to God's word. We grow in our love for him and others.



#### The Angelus

The Angelus is a prayer in which we thank and praise God for Jesus Christ, the Savior of the world. Some Catholic churches ring their church bells at 6:00 A.M., at 12:00 noon, and at 6:00 P.M. When they do, they are following the tradition of praying the Angelus. The ringing of the bells calls us to pray during the day.



# Mith My Family

#### This Week ....

In chapter 11, "Celebrating God's Love for Us," your child learned that the liturgy is the Church's work of worshiping God. The liturgy of the Church centers around the Eucharist and the other sacraments. In the liturgy the members of the Church gather with Christ, the Head of the Church, to remember and share in his Paschal Mystery. The Paschal Mystery of Christ is his saving Passion, death, Resurrection, and Ascension. The Church gathers to receive God's blessing and to bless and give thanks to the Father. What Jesus did while he was on earth is made present here and now. We join with Christ all year long and share in his work of Salvation. We call the Church year of worship the liturgical year.
