## An Evergreen Tree

The evergreen tree reminds us of the gift of eternal life that Jesus offers us. The tree is shaped like an arrow, pointing up to our heavenly home. The lights shine like the stars over Bethlehem.

*He gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should ... have eternal life. John 3:16*

## A Wreath

The green wreath is a sign of new life, even in the dark of winter. The circle shape of the wreath reminds us that God's love is never-ending. He comes to be with us forever!

*"I am the Alpha and the Omega, ... the beginning and the end." Revelation 22:13*

## Thre Prophet's Candle

The first candle on our Advent wreath is called "The Prophet's Candle." Prophets like Isaiah shared God's message. God told the people to get ready for the promised Savior: a light to shine in the darkened world. ## John the Baptist

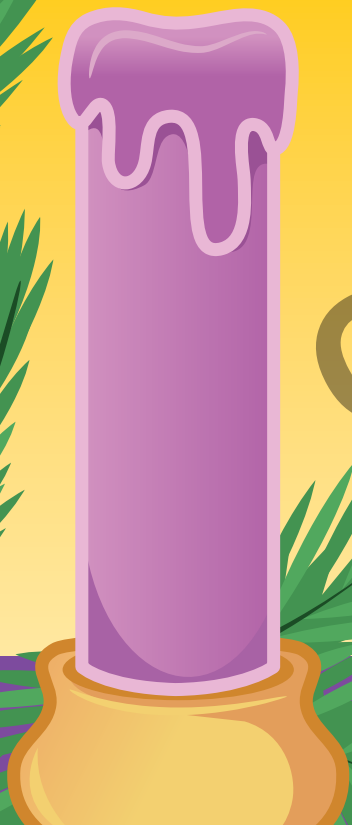
John was a prophet. He tells us to prepare for Jesus' coming. When people asked John about the promised Messiah, John pointed them to Jesus, "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."

*"I am the voice of one crying out in the wilderness, 'Make straight the way of the Lord.'" John 1:23*

The prophets foretold that the Savior would come. God's light would soon shine out to guide everyone. I light my first candle and pray this first prayer: "Dear Jesus, you're coming. Please help me prepare."

John lived near the river. When people came near, John told them, "Prepare! For the Lord's almost here!"

I want to be ready. "Dear Jesus, come in! Make your home in my heart. Make my heart pure within."



## Mary and Joseph

Good news, Mary, "you will bear a son and call his name Jesus." Joseph got that same message. They welcomed God's Son. The news is for you too. Through Jesus, you are part of God's family! Pray, "Come, Lord Jesus!"

"Let it be as God has said."

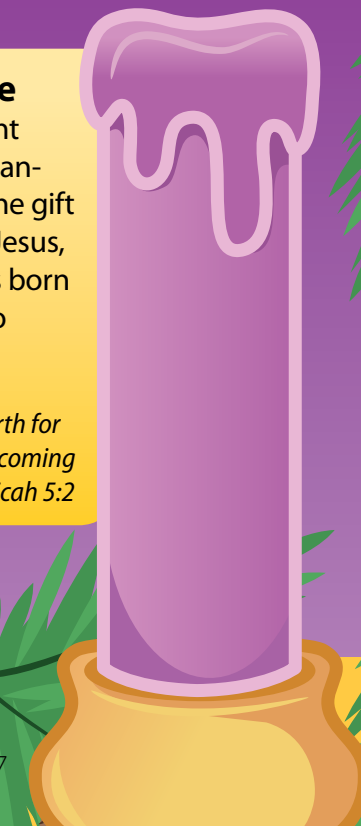
Joseph heard the news as well.

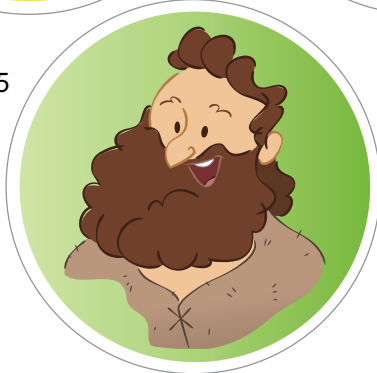
