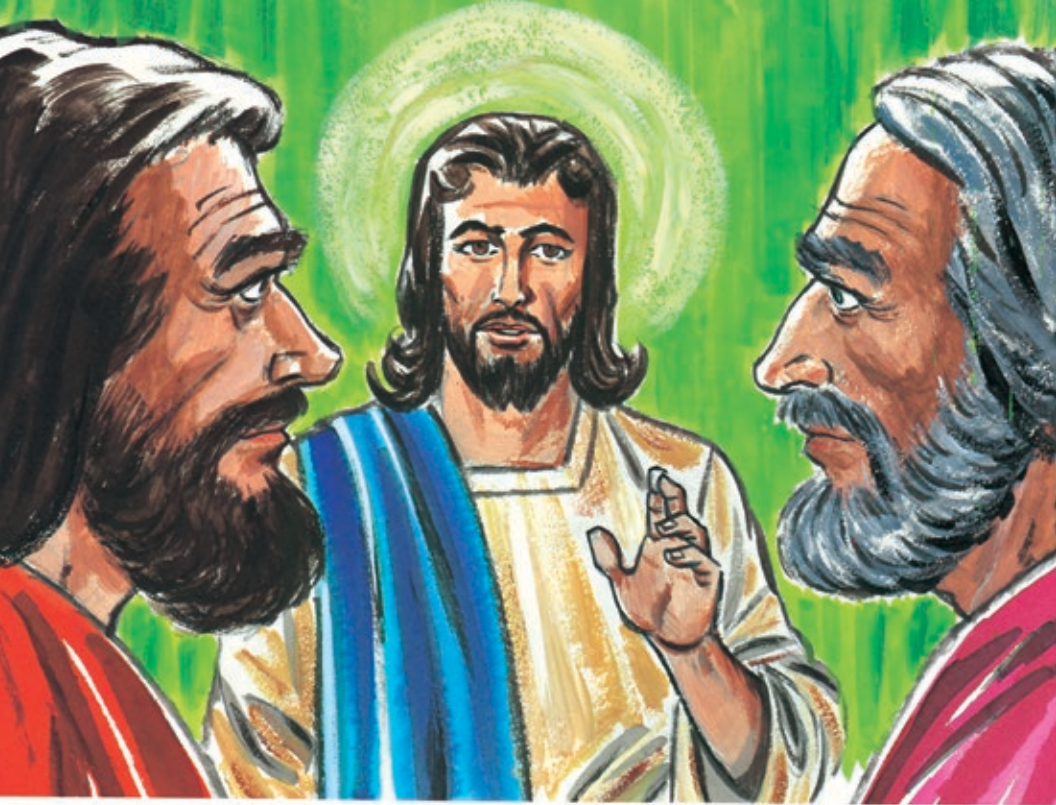

## **2<sup>nd</sup> SPIRITUAL WORK OF MERCY**

### **To Instruct the Ignorant**

#### ***Jesus speaks:***

**“Your light must shine before men so that they may see goodness in your acts and give praise to your heavenly Father.”**

**(Matthew 5:16)**
