Reading the Word of God

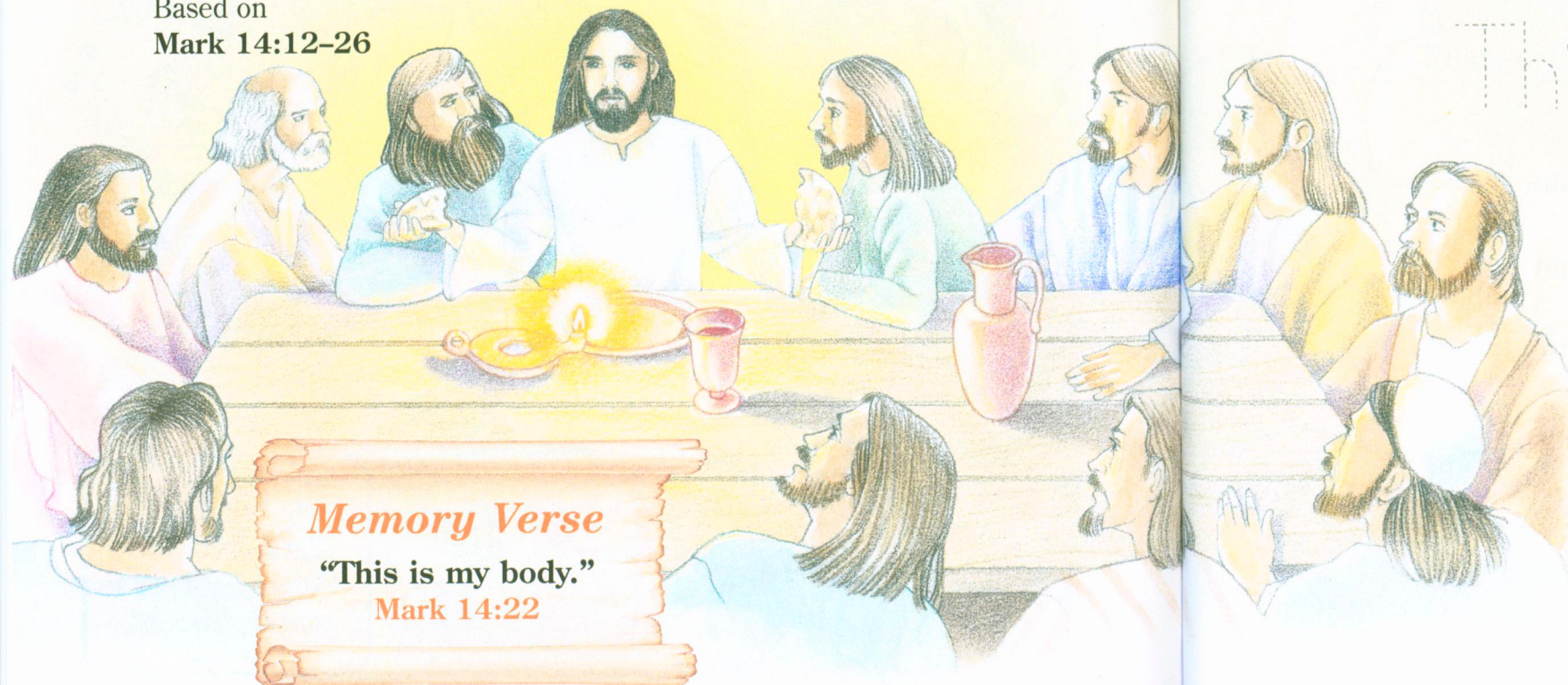
Jesus sent two disciples to find a place to celebrate Passover. When they found a home, they prepared for the special meal.

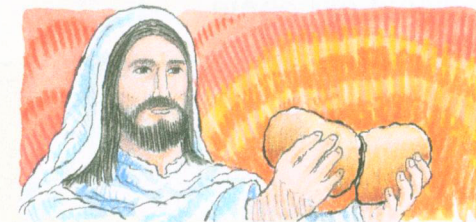
Understanding the Word of God

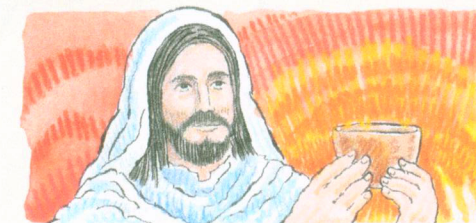
