Bible Background

After the Last Supper, a crowd arrested Jesus in the garden of Gethsemani and took him to Caiaphas, the high priest. Then the Sanhedrin, the supreme council of the Jewish people, accused Jesus of blasphemy. The Sanhedrin said that he claimed to be God. Next, the leaders took Jesus to Pilate, the Roman procurator.
