2 Pray an Our Father, 3 Hail Marys, and the Glory Be. **4** Repeat step 3 for each of the next 4 mysteries.

Make the Sign of the Cross and pray the Apostles' Creed.

Catholics pray the Rosary to honor Mary and remember the important events in the lives of Jesus and Mary. There are twenty mysteries of the Rosary. Follow the steps from 1 to 5.

- 1. The Annunciation
- 2. The Visitation
- 3. The Nativity
- 4. The Presentation in the Temple
- 5. The Finding of the Child Jesus After Three Days in the Temple

Sharing in the Eucharist joins us most fully to Christ and to the Church. We receive the Body and Blood of Christ.


Act of Contrition

The INTRODUCTORY RITES
