



- † They were the first man and woman, created by God in his image and likeness.




- † God made a covenant with him—an unconditional promise of faithfulness.

- † She sang praise to God for working through unexpected heroes.




- † They appointed scribes and judges to establish law and order.

- [†] Under their leadership, the people rededicated themselves to God and the Covenant.




- † God called him to be a prophet through a powerful vision in the Temple.
