Some teachers donated toys and my family donated money as well. We raised \$1100 & many toys. I took the toys and money to the hospital to deliver it for all the children. Each year I help with the fundraiser at my school. We have raised thousands of dollars for the hospital. Each year my 2 sisters and I have our own fundraiser. We set up a lemonade stand with snacks and lemonade in the front yard of our house to raise money for the hospital. We raise hundreds of dollars each year with our lemonade stand. We take the money and go shopping at a local toy store to buy toys for kids of all ages. My sisters and I choose toys we think the other kids will like & enjoy. We decorate boxes with pictures and put the toys and money in them. We also make cards with our class at school & bring them. We drive to the hospital to deliver them. We have done this for the last 3 years. I would like to keep doing this every year. I want to help all of the children that visit the hospital every year. I also joined a service group at my school where we have fundraisers for many organizations throughout the entire school year.

It makes me feel good to help other kids. It is a good thing to help other people. Helping the hospital brings me closer to God, because he helps people. I think God saved me so I can do good things in this world. In my life, I want to always help others like God has taught me. When I am an adult I want to continue to help the hospital for what they did for me when I was a kid.
